

# Sacha Lodge

Remote yet accessible, unspoilt yet comfortable, Sacha Lodge has protected the fabulous wildlife for more than 20 years, enabling it to flourish. The all-inclusive jungle lodge is the ideal base to explore the fascinating rainforest in small groups, led by expert guides.



## CANOPY WALK

Explore the rainforest canopy along a 94-foot high [36m] bridge above the treetops! This 940-foot long [275m] sturdy walkway offers an astounding opportunity to spot dozens of animals.



## KAPOK TOWER

You'll feel like you're on the very top of the world on the 135-foot [43m] observation tower, a platform built on the highest branches of a giant kapok tree.



## CANOPY CRANE

Take a high-flying ride up 150 feet [45m] above the forest floor into the canopy of the amazing Amazon Rainforest in a hot air balloon-like basket. Explore nearly two acres [.78 hectares] of rainforest canopy with its 150 foot [45m] long boom.



## MORNING FOREST WALKS

Creeping along jungle paths, your naturalist guide might take you through the territory of crested owls or howler monkeys, mimicking the creatures' calls to win their trust and coax them out of hiding.



### **CAIMAN SPOTING**

A nighttime expedition to look for caimans on the lake is a magical experience filled with wonder. You will take a canoe out onto the water under the cover of darkness, with glittering stars lighting the way.



### **BUTTERFLY HOUSE**

The Butterfly House was designed as a live exhibition conservatory, where guests will be shown how these beautiful insects are bred and raised. Later, roam through 'the flying room' where hundreds of colourful butterflies flutter from flower to flower.



### **LAKE POOL**

The Lodge's plunge pool, the only one of its kind in the Amazon region, is protected on all sides by a mesh cage that allows you to cool off in the black waters of Pilchicocha Lake. You may even spot a caiman or giant otters swimming by on the other side.



### **NIGHT FOREST WALKS**

When darkness falls, have your flashlight ready to spot creatures of the night such as tarantulas, frogs, boas and stick insects while the rainforest symphony unfolds around you.



### **CREEK PADDLING**

Creek paddling in dug-out canoes is a fabulous adventure, with the bonus that it requires little physical exertion. Paddling down the streams is like entering a tunnel leading into a lost world.
